Whereas: many townships throughout Minnesota depend on local volunteer First Responder groups for initial medical care in a crisis, now

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Minnesota Association of Townships pursues getting Frist Responder groups added to those organizations that the Minnesota Legislature authorizes townships to donate to.
