RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN ORDER TO SET A HEARING ON THE PETITION TO VACATE A PORTION OF 499th LANE

WHEREAS, the board of supervisors ("Town Board") of Logan Township ("Town") received a petition, attached hereto as <u>Exhibit A</u>, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 164.07 requesting the vacation of a portion of 499th Lane described as follows ("Road Segment"):

That part of Logan Township Road (499th Lane) lying westerly of the East line of Section 16, Township 49, Range 25, Aitkin County, Minnesota;

WHEREAS, the petition appears sufficient under the statute to be processed as the Town Clerk has reviewed the signatures and has determined it contains the signatures of at least eight voters of the Town who own real estate within three miles of the Road Segment;

WHEREAS, those owning property directly abutting the Road Segment proposed for vacation are as follows (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Affected Owners"):

WHEREAS, Gregory & Sara Ries propose to quit claim deed the following described portion of their property to the Town to provide the public access to the south east corner of the State's property:

That part of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼ of NE ¼) of Section 16, Township 49, Range 25, Aitkin County, Minnesota described as follows: The North 33.00 feet of the East 33.00 feet of said NE ¼- NE ¼;

WHEREAS, Minn. Stat. § 164.07, subd. 2 requires the Town Board to make an order describing as nearly as practicable the road to be vacated, describing the several tracts of land through which the road passes, and fixing a time and place when and where the Town Board will meet and act upon petition; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board hereby finds and determines the following with respect to the notice that must be provided at the hearing called for by the Order:

- a. As required by Minn. Stat. § 164.07, subd. 2(a), the petitioners are responsible for serving a copy of this Order and the vacation petition on the Affected Owners at least 10 days before the date of the hearing;
- b. The Road Segment proposed for vacation leads to land owned by the State, but does not terminate at, abut upon, and is not adjacent to any public water;
- c. The Town will post notice of the hearing at its usual posting place at least 10 days before the date of the hearing; and
- d. The Town will publish notice of the hearing once in its official newspaper at least 10 days before the date of the hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board hereby orders as follows:

- 2. The Town Board shall conduct an on-site inspection of the Road Segment prior to the hearing at 530 p.m. on Feb 37, 2012 to examine the Road Segment as required by Minn. Stat. § 164.07, subd. 3.
- 3. The petitioners are responsible for providing notice of the hearing consistent with the Town Board's findings and determinations indicated above and for providing the Town an affidavit of having provided the required notices at or before the beginning of the hearing. If the Town does not receive sufficient proof of the required notices having been provided, the Town will not proceed with the hearing.
- 4. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to provide the petitioners a signed copy of this Order, to provide at least 10 days' published notice of the hearing, and to post a copy of this Order at the Town's posting place at least 10 days before the date of the hearing.
- 5. If the Town Board determines to grant the requested vacation, the petitioners shall be responsible for preparing a revised legal description of the Road Segment if the present description is not acceptable to the County Recorder to record the vacation order.
- 6. The Town Chairperson and Clerk are authorized to contact the Town's attorney as needed for assistance in carrying out the Town Board's obligations under this process.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL

Any persons affected by this process have the right of appeal as provided in Minn. Stat. § 164.07, subd. 7 to seek judicial review of the Town Board's decision if it does decide to vacate the Road Segment.
