This combined polling place serves all territory located in Independent School District No. 1 located in the City of Aitkin; City of Palisade; Aitkin Township, Farm Island Township, Hazelton Township, Morrison Township, Nordland Township, Spencer Township, Glen Township, Kimberly Township, Lakeside Township, Lee Township, Malmo Township, Wealthwood Township, Fleming Township, Libby (West) Township, Logan Township, Verdon Township, Waukenabo Township, Workman Township and unorganized territory all in Aitkin County, Minnesota; and Dean Lake Township, Deerwood Township, Rabbit Lake Township, and Ross Lake Township all in Crow Wing County, Minnesota.

Any eligible voter residing in the School District may vote at said election at the combined polling place designated above for the precinct in which he or she resides. The polls for said election will be opened at 7:00 o'clock a.m. and will close at 8:00 o'clock p.m. on the date of said election.

A voter must be registered to vote to be eligible to vote in this election. An unregistered individual may register to vote at the combined polling place on election day.
