

**Logan Town Board Meeting Minutes
November 12, 2024**

On November 12th, 2024 the Logan Town Board held its monthly meeting at the Palisade Community Center. Vice Chair Lisa Bryan called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm.

Present: Supervisor Dave Sims, Supervisor Elissa Bryan, Supervisor Lynn Mizner, Treasurer Michelle Pieterse, Clerk Craig LeBlanc and Rod Kern.

- David Sims moved to approve the September 2024 and October 2024 minutes, second by Lisa Bryan. Motion passed with all in favor.

Board of Canvass:

Old Business:

- Campaign Financial Report Certificates of filing were received from each candidate.

Roads:

- Workman Townline Road Agreement was signed.
- Waukenabo Townline Road Agreement: Review and discuss at the December meeting.
- Ditch at corner of 330th Avenue and 480th Street filled in by property owner Robert Collins. A driveway at that location requires at least a 15" culvert.

New Business:

- Logan Township Cannabis resolution: Review and discuss at the December meeting.
- Aitkin County Cannabis is proposing a Joint Power Agreement with cities/townships. The Cannabis Ordinance public hearing is 11-22-24, 10:15 am, Aitkin County Government Center.
- Aitkin County Strategic Planning Focus Group: Review of the proposed 2025 Aitkin County Budget (4% proposed levy increase) followed by feedback from cities, townships and organizations on issues of EMS coverage, education, recreation and economic development.
- ACAT Meeting: County issues are solid waste, water quality, levies/taxes, property cleanup, mental health resources, EMS and rural transportation funding. Next meeting includes ACAT director elections and voting on bylaws for at large representation in ACAT districts without candidates.
- MAT Annual Conference: Lynn Mizner, Michelle Pieterse and Craig LeBlanc have registered.
- City of Palisade: 2026 Fire Protection Agreement was signed.
