

**Logan Town Board Meeting Minutes
October 14, 2025**

On October 14th, 2025 the Logan Town Board held its monthly meeting at the Palisade Community Center. Chair Dave Sims called the meeting to order at 7:03 pm.

Present: Chair Dave Sims, Supervisor Elissa Bryan, Supervisor Lynn Mizner,
Treasurer Michelle Pieterse, Clerk Craig LeBlanc, Kris Milbradt and Rod Kern.

- Lisa Bryan moved to approve the September 2025 Logan Town Board Meeting minutes, second by Dave Sims. Motion passed, all in favor.
- Dave Sims moved to approve the Treasurer's Financial Statement with a balance of \$134,615.04, second by Lisa Bryan. Motion passed, all in favor.
- The Clerk's books balance with the Treasurer's books.

Old Business:

- Logan Township was not notified that a septic pumping service is applying sewage to private property in Logan Township.
- The SAM (System Award Management) registration was renewed October 2nd. The final distribution report is due April 2026 for the SLFRF (State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds) received in 2021/2022.

New Business:

- The 2026 Logan Town levy was submitted to the Aitkin County Auditor on September 29th.
- LRIP (Local Road Improvement Program) funding is typically given for roads that are part of trunk highway projects or roads of regional significance.

Roads:

- Beaver dams were removed from the minimum maintenance road.
- 460th Lane West is on the priority list for grading/gravel
- Logan map with FD (Federal Ditch) / SD (State Ditch) / JD (Judicial Ditch) / CD (County Ditch) and FRC (Fire Relief Commission) ditches.

Cemetery:

- Two burial plots were sold.
- Pine Grove Chapel Project - Recent donations total \$3167, with \$3000 from the Grand Rapids Area Community Foundation and \$167 in cash.
- The designation of the Pine Grove Chapel as a chapel may be limiting donations that people or organizations can or will give.
- Pine Grove Chapel electrical service is connected.
- Donation mailer will be reviewed.


