On November 13th, 2025 the Logan Town Board held its monthly meeting at the Palisade Community Center. Chair Dave Sims called the meeting to order at 7:04 pm.

**Old Business:**

- Clerk will ask the county if there is a notification process for pumping of sewage on private land.

**New Business:**

- Border to Border Broadband Grant for Logan Township approved in 2023 for the northern third of Logan Township. Most of the properties under this grant are not connected to broadband internet service.
- The MAT Annual meeting is December 11-13 in St. Cloud. Dave Sims plans on attending and Clerk Craig LeBlanc is considering attending.

**Roads:**

- Logan Township will bill Waukenabo Township for road maintenance that they are responsible for in the current townline road agreement.
- 460th Lane east of Nature Avenue is not a township road. A property owner asking about repairs was informed that those who own property adjacent to the road can decide how to repair and maintain it.

- Mark Goers will store the furniture from the Pine Grove Chapel at his property in the City of Palisade.
