April 8, 2025

On April 8, 2025 the Logan Town Board held its monthly meeting at the Palisade Community Center. Chair Dave Sims called the meeting to order at 7:07 pm.

Present: Chair Dave Sims, Supervisor Elissa Bryan, Supervisor Lynn Mizner, Treasurer Michelle Pieterse and Clerk Craig LeBlanc.

- Lisa Bryan moved to approve the March 2025 Logan Town Board Meeting minutes, second by David Sims. Motion passed, all in favor. LISA/
- David Sims moved to approve the Treasurer's Financial Statement with a balance of \$177,337.15, second by Lisa Bryan. Motion passed, all in favor.
- The Clerk's books balance with the Treasurer's books.

Old Business:

- Calcium chloride cost is \$290 and the request for is due by May 16.
- ARPA: SLFRF 2025 Annual Project & Expenditure Report submitted.
- Letter of thanks received from STS for donation.

Roads:

- New culverts require a permit from the township.
- Trees 6" or larger that are removed from the right of way must be offered to the property owner or removed if the property owner does not want them.
- Road review should be scheduled for May.

- Fundraising for the Pine Grove Chapel will continue. Ideas include a mailer with information/updates about the project and a donation request.


