


## Pine Grove Cemetery of Logan Township Minnesota



## Cemetery Policies

- 
- A thorough cleaning of the cemetery takes place annually each spring. At this time, all ornamentation will be disposed of by Logan Township.
  - Except for the period beginning one week prior to Memorial Day and ending June 15th, no flower containers or other items that obstruct mowing are to be left on gravesites. No imitation flowers with wire stems that obstruct mowing are permitted in the cemetery. Shepherd's hooks with hanging planters, as well as contained gardens, are acceptable provided they do not obstruct mowing. Any items found in violation of these rules after this period will be properly disposed of by Logan Township.
  - Any potted plants must be weighted and secured so that the pot and arrangement stay in place during windy conditions.
  - No flowers, wild or cultivated, shall be picked in the cemetery. No tree, shrub, or other plant shall be marred. No monument shall be damaged or defaced.
  - No new trees are to be planted without approval of Logan Township.
  - No person shall make any excavation, set any mound, set or reset any monument without getting written permission from Logan Township.
  - No advertising of any kind may be displayed.
  - No liquor of any kind shall be consumed on the premises.
  - No littering is allowed.



## Monuments, Markers and Memorials

- Monuments are to be placed on a slab of concrete or stone that is a minimum of 4 inches thick, with 4 to 6 inches extending around the edge of the monument at the ground level.
- Prior authorization from Logan Township is required before installation of any base, monument, or marker.
- No monuments, markers or memorials may be constructed of wood.
- Any damage incurred to the cemetery by the installer shall be the responsibility of the installer and said installer will be billed accordingly, with payment due upon receipt of statement for damages.
- Logan Township is not responsible for any base, monument, marker or memorial workmanship.
- No bases, markers or monuments shall be brought into Pine Grove Cemetery and left there prior to installation and construction.
- No bases, monuments or markers shall be set or installed between November 1st and May 1<sup>st</sup> except by prior Logan Township approval according to weather and ground conditions.

## Lots, Graves and Interments

- Full size gravesites will contain no more than 1 casket and 1 cremation, or no casket and 2 cremations except in the case of 3

cremations consisting ONLY of a 2-adult family and 1 infant.

- Full size gravesites are only permitted to have one upright stone (head) and one flat stone (foot).
- No burials may take place without notification and permission of Logan Township. All burials must be done through the contracted excavator by Logan Township.
- Plots or gravesites may not be privately resold. They may be only sold back to Logan Township for the original purchase price.
- Plots with no known family members will revert back to Logan Township as per Minnesota State Statutes, Chapter 306.
- No mound sites are permitted.

## Fees

- Gravesite Digging: \$1,000, also dependent on burial conditions and seasonal costs.
- Cremation Digging: \$500, also dependent on burial conditions and seasonal costs.
- Grave Marking: \$35
- Gravesites:
  - Resident / Related to Resident: \$300
  - Non-Resident: \$600
- Pine Grove Chapel Rental: \$100 for up to four hours. Additional costs may be incurred depending on event. Contact Logan Township for more information.

## Rules For Visitors

- Do not tamper with anything that does not belong to you.
- Do not complain to or question the employees/contractors on duty.
- Drive only on the dirt driveways. Do not drive or park on the grass.
- Walk in the walkways, and not on the graves.
- No picnics, parties or camping are permitted within the cemetery grounds.
- No snowmobiles or off road/all-terrain vehicles permitted unless visiting and using proper driveways.
- Out of respect for all who visit and those at rest here, loud noises and disturbances are not permitted.
- No firearms allowed except by authorized military personnel participating in funeral service of military veteran.
- Please show respect for this sacred ground and those who rest here.

*Cemetery Disclaimer: The cemetery shall take reasonable precautions to protect all property within its grounds; however, it shall not be held liable for any loss or damage resulting from acts of vandalism, malicious mischief, or any force majeure events, including but not limited to acts of nature such as windstorms, tornadoes, cyclones, hail, snow, frost, fire, explosions, lightning, or other unforeseeable occurrences beyond its control.*
