

**Logan Town Board Meeting Minutes
February 10, 2026**

On February 10th, 2026 the Logan Town Board held its monthly meeting at the Palisade Community Center. Chair Dave Sims called the meeting to order at 7:13 pm.

Present: Chair Dave Sims, Supervisor Elissa Bryan, Supervisor Lynn Mizner,
Treasurer Michelle Pieterse and Clerk Craig LeBlanc.

- Lisa Bryan moved to approve the January 2026 Logan Town Board Meeting minutes, second by Lynn Mizner. Motion passed, all in favor.
- Dave Sims moved to approve the Treasurer's Financial Statement with a balance of \$141,988.68, second by Lynn Mizner. Motion passed, all in favor.
- The Clerk's books balance with the Treasurer's books.

- The U.S Census Bureau Boundary and Annexation Survey was completed with no changes.

Roads:

- Waukenabo: Billing for 2025 road maintenance:
 - Plowing \$175.00 (1/24 of \$4,200.00 total cost)
 - Grading \$945.00
 - Brushing \$122.50 (1/2 of \$245.00 cost)
 - Mowing \$66.67 (1/24th of \$1600.00 total cost)
 - Total \$1,309.17**

New Business:

- January 2025 ACAT Meeting:
 - Craig LeBlanc was elected as an ACAT at large director.
 - North Ambulance discussed operating losses and funding options.
 - MAT District 11 Reno Wells is retiring in August.
- Group Term Life Insurance from the Minnesota Benefit Association. Minimum coverage increased to \$5000 and the premium increased \$80. Officers over 70 years old receive a 50% benefit and those over 75 years old receive a 25% benefit. The coverage will be discussed at the Annual Meeting and a decision made at the regular town board meeting.

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Cemetery:

- The first phase of the Pine Grove Chapel project is not completed. The town board will contact John Biaganek to discuss the project.

- Lisa Bryan moved to approve claims, second by Lynn Mizner. Motion passed, all in favor.
