

Logan Town Board Meeting Minutes
April 15, 2026

On April 15th, 2026 the Logan Town Board held its monthly meeting at the Palisade Community Center. Chair Dave Sims called the meeting to order at 7:02 pm.

Present: Chair Dave Sims, Supervisor Elissa Bryan, Supervisor Lynn Mizner, Treasurer Michelle Pieterse, Clerk Craig LeBlanc, Josh Joerger, Diane Ladd, Larry Ladd and Reno Williams.

- Lisa Bryan moved to approve the March 2026 Logan Town Board Meeting minutes, second by Dave Sims. Motion passed, all in favor.
- Dave Sims moved to approve the Treasurer's Financial Statement with a balance of \$144,765.76, second by Lisa Bryan. Motion passed, all in favor.
- Lisa Bryan moved to approve the February 2026 Board of Audit minutes, second by Lynn Mizner. Motion passed, all in favor.
- The Clerk's books balance with the Treasurer's books.

Old Business:

- MAT District 11 Director Reno Williams spoke in support of Dave Sim's MAT sponsored trip to Washington D.C. and mentioned that township support is an allowable expense. He also supports Dave's election to the District 11 Director position, which will be determined by an in-person vote at the MAT District 11 Meeting on August 26, 2026 at the Walker Area Community Center.
- The Logan Township 2027 Levy was submitted to the Aitkin County Auditor on March 12, 2026.
- Clerk Election Training is in May.
- Election Judge Training is June and July. The 2024 election judges will be contacted to see if they are available for training and election judge duties. The Treasurer's full term is up for election, so Michelle Pieterse will not be able to serve as an election judge on November 3rd if she is on the ballot.

Roads:

- Waukenabo Township Supervisor Josh Joerger discussed 340th Place maintenance, which has not followed the current maintenance agreement. There is no charge for Waukenabo's part of the agreement that was paid by Logan Township in 2025. Josh will talk with Rod Kern to find out how the work on 340th has been billed and suggest that future bills have the charges broken down by road. The townships will discuss the maintenance agreement after more information is available.
- Spring Road Review: The supervisors and clerk will individually inspect the roads.

New Business:

- Lynn Mizner moved to pay \$1,400.00 to Dave Sims for the MAT Washington D.C. trip expenses, second by Lisa Bryan. Motion passed with Dave Sims abstaining.
- MAT Spring Short Courses: April 16th at the Sugar Lake Lodge in Cohasset.
- ACAT Meeting: April 16th, 7:00 pm at the Aitkin County Government Center.

Cemetery:

- Pine Grove Chapel Project: Windows installed and ramp/landing construction has started. Work will resume in 3 weeks.
- Jeff Wiberg quoted \$2925.00 for restoration of the floors. The board will ask if he is willing to leave minor defects (to keep the cost down and retain some of the character of the building).

Motion to Approve Claims:

- Dave Sims moved to approve claims, second by Lisa Bryan. Motion passed, all in favor.

Motion to Adjourn:

- Dave Sims moved to adjourn, second by Lisa Bryan. Motion passed, all in favor.
