

**Logan Town Board Meeting Minutes
May 12, 2026**

On May 12th, 2026 the Logan Town Board held its monthly meeting at the Palisade Community Center. Vice Chair Lisa Bryan called the meeting to order at 7:06 pm.

Present: Supervisor Elissa Bryan, Supervisor Lynn Mizner, Treasurer Michelle Pieterse, Clerk Craig LeBlanc, Diane Ladd, Larry Ladd and Rod Kern. David Sims attended by phone.

- Lynn Mizner moved to approve the March 2026 Logan Town Board Meeting minutes, second by Lisa Bryan. Motion passed with David Sims abstaining.
- Lisa Bryan moved to approve the Treasurer's Financial Statement with a balance of \$144,765.76, second by Lynn Mizner. Motion passed with David Sims abstaining.
- The Clerk's books balance with the Treasurer's books.

Old Business:

- Clerk Election Training completed. Treasurer and Supervisor seat C seats are up for election.
- Paid Leave was submitted for 2026 Quarter 1. The township portion of the payment is considered income and is taxed for Social Security and Medicare.
- All election judges will receive a W-2 for wages to comply with the Paid Leave system. Social Security and Medicare tax will not be withheld until compensation meets or exceeds \$2,500.

Roads:

- Spring Road Review: Not all roads were inspected and the full report will be reviewed in June.
- Lisa Bryan moved to accept the Kern Excavating contract, second by Lynn Mizner. Motion passed with David Sims not voting.
- Lynn Mizner moved to accept the 2026 roadside mowing quote of \$1,700 from Isaac Hart, second by Lisa Bryan. Motion passed with David Sims abstaining.

New Business:

- MAT Spring Courses: Paid Leave, Ex-Officio Notary not restricted to township business, road liability.
- ACAT Meeting: Aitkin County Recorder Tara Snyder talked about alerts for fraudulent actions on property.
- Township Elections:
 - Treasurer and Supervisor C full terms are up for election.
 - For 2026, the clerk is recommending these 2024 Logan Township election judges:
 - Diane Buranen, Jim Buranen, Emily DuRose, Chris Gamer, Nancy O'Connor, Lynn Mizner, Michelle Pieterse, David Sims, Megan Sims, David Stephani, Tammi Stephani, Margaret Sveum.
 - Election judges should be appointed by the town board no later than the June 9th 2026 town board meeting to allow time to schedule election judge training in June and July. All election judges are now trained by Aitkin County as head judges.
 - 7 election judges are needed for each election to have 3 per shift and one alternate per election. The clerk only plans on serving as an election judge as an alternate.
 - 2 election judges are required to pick up election materials and to drop off ballots and election materials when the polls close.

Cemetery:

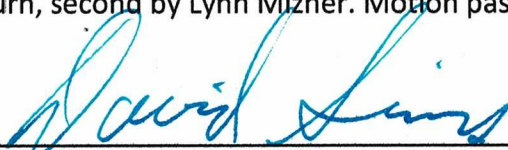
- Pine Grove Chapel: A memorial day open house is planned for Sunday, May 24th. Basic interior work will be completed and the entrance ramp will be completed.
